
All meetings are held at 5:00pm at PMP's office located at 340 Edmond Road Suite. E, Kearneysville, WV (near the DMV)

WHAT'S NEW IN YOUR COMMUNITY UPKEEP & REPAIRS

Multiple dead trees have been removed in common areas by a local licensed vendor that the Board has approved. Ongoing inspections will continue in all of these areas to see what else will need to be removed for safety reasons.

The Board has approved the following projects:

- Paving and road repair project on Douglas Drive in the coming months. As this project moves forward, PMP will notify the community in advance so everyone is aware of when this will be taking place.
- Repairs to the tot lot as well as expanding the play area out further to add new play equipment.
- The circle around Camden Court is going to be widened.
