Angela.suddueth@pmpbiz.com (681) 252-0217 ext. 1903 **SNOW** and **ICE** are a fact of life in West Virginia during the winter months. When temperatures drop and snow starts falling, PMP is faced with questions and complaints about snow and ice removal.

Please remember that homeowners are responsible for removing snow and ice from paved walkways and sidewalks around their property. Snow removal in common areas will begin once 3-4 inches of snow has fallen and ice melt will be spread once ¼ inch of ice has accumulated. When snow begins to fall, if at all possible, we ask that you do not park your vehicles on the street so that the snow plows have a more direct path to clear the streets.

Despite the association's efforts to keep the property reasonably free of snow and ice, the association does not guarantee or promise protection against these hazards. Homeowners therefore must proceed cautiously during winter months.



For many of us, **'trash night'** denotes a chore, something that we just don't feel like doing. One of the problems that many homeowners face is that waste is only picked up once a week, leaving trash to the elements, including animals, plenty of time to cause a mess of problems that do anything but pile up...usually, they scatter... everywhere. On windy, trash days, assume the worst, even if it's calm in the morning. Trash can be collected at any point during the day, and the weather may not be so kind by the time the trash truck shows up.

Trash bins should be weighed down. Your bins should be heavy enough not to blow around in the wind. Don't leave any cardboard boxes or plastic bottles in recycling bins without a lid. Try securing trash bins by using bungee cords to keep them down. Sometimes the wind can catch the lip of the lid and flip it, resulting in a mess. **Trash bins are to be stored out of public view.**

HOLIDAY BARS

Ingredients

1 roll (16.5 oz) Pillsbury[™] refrigerated chocolate chip cookies

¹/₄ cup unsweetened baking cocoa

- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips (from 12-oz bag)
- 1 cup peanut butter chips (from 10-oz bag)
- 2 cups flaked coconut
- 1 cup M&M's[™] red and green (holiday) candy-coated chocolate candies (from 10.7-oz bag)
- 1 cup salted cocktail peanuts, coarsely chopped
- 1 can (14 oz) sweetened condensed milk (not evaporated)

Directions

- 1. Heat oven to 350°F. Line 13x9-inch pan with heavy-duty foil, extending foil over sides of pan. Spray with cooking spray.
- 2. In medium bowl, crumble cookie dough; stir or knead in cocoa until well mixed (dough will be stiff). Press dough evenly in bottom of pan. Top evenly with chocolate chips, peanut butter chips, coconut, chocolate candies and peanuts. Pour sweet-ened condensed milk evenly over bars.
- 3. Bake 30 to 35 minutes or until edges are golden brown (center will not be set). Cool completely, about 2 hours. Use foil to lift bars from pan. For bars, cut into 6 rows by 4 rows. Store covered in refrigerator.

Expert Tip

Foil lining the pan makes pan removal and cutting of bars easier.


